Hello Mr. Mercer,

The Town received \$20,921.50 from Worcester for the Airport, based on a property value of \$1,403,186 last fiscal year. The Town received \$25,023.98 from Worcester for water protection land, based on a property value of \$1,678,336 last fiscal year.

Both of these amounts are based on the valuation/1000 times the tax rate, so they are paying the proper value of the land.

I am not aware of any fees paid by Worcester for water in Leicester, as they own those resources.
